The **Celebration of Grassroots Organizing** is an expression of increased impact through collaborative fundraising. 15 partner organizations (*listed on the left*) work together on the frontlines of movements for justice and liberation in Boston and collaboratively plan the Celebration as a chance to uplift this collective work. All income goes to a democratically controlled fund that is shared and split between the partners.

11 years ago, a dozen friends of two allied organizations shared a lobster meal in the backyard of Haymarket People's Fund and raised about \$2,000. **At this year's lobster picnic, we'll bring together over 700 people to raise \$250,000, bringing our total income since the event's start to \$1 million.**

Table Hosts:

Treat your friends to a lobster dinner:

- You can buy a full or a half table, at either the 1 PM or 5 PM seating.
 - Full table of 10 seats: Sliding scale \$500 – \$1,000
 - Half table of 5 seats: Sliding Scale \$250 – \$500
- You may purchase the table by making a donation (Details in footer)
- You will receive a promo code allowing your guests to register for your table for free [online](#).

Table Captains:

Organize friends to join your table, but they can buy their own ticket:

- Reserve a full table (10 seats) or half table (5 seats) for your friends, at either the 1 PM or 5 PM seating.
- When tickets go on sale March 1, send the [registration link](#) to your friends along with a promo code, and they can purchase a ticket for your table using that code.
- They'll also receive a 10% discount on their ticket purchase by using that code! (Regular ticket prices are \$50, \$100, and \$150).
- You are only responsible for purchasing your own ticket.
